

**How to use this devotional:**

Begin your devotional time with prayer, specifically seeking God's wisdom in understanding and applying the scripture for the day.

Read the passage for the day 2-3 times so that you become familiar with it.

Read through the questions and then read the passage once more thinking about how it answers the questions. (not all of the questions have answers that are found in the passage)

Write out your answers to the questions.

Write down any other thoughts or questions that you have about the passage.

Spend some time in prayer, worshipping God for who he is and what you've learned about him, as well as confessing sin and praying for specific prayer requests.

How has what you learned about love in the first week affected your life?

What have you learned since week 1 that helps answer the question "what makes love the greatest of faith, hope, and love"?

How should God's love for us affect our love for others?

What will you do this week to carry someone else's burdens?

**Day 51:** Review the passages and your answers from week 2

What is the motivation behind love, both God's love for us and our love for each other?

What is significant about the recurring theme of love in the book of Ephesians?

How did these passages affect your view of love?

Who can you love this week that you haven't been loving recently?

**Day 52:** Review the passages and your answers from week 3

How do the false teachings from day 17 distort our view of love?

What role does the Holy Spirit play in our love for each other?

What is significant about the theme of love in I John?

How has God used someone else to show you love recently?

**Day 53:** Review the passages and your answers from week 4

What is similar between Jesus' teaching on love and the Apostles' teaching?

How does the teacher's response in Mark 12 correspond to David's writing in Psalm 51?

What does Jesus' life tell us about God's love?

What can you do this next week to demonstrate your love for God?

**Day 54:** Review the passages and your answers from week 5

How has your definition of agape changed in light of your study in the weeks since week 5?

How has God shown his love for you recently?

What are some implications of the church being a body as Paul describes?

What can you do this next week to promote unity in your church?

**Day 55:** Review the passages and your answers from week 6

How does obeying the commands that Paul gives us demonstrate love for others?

What is the implication of Paul's commands with regard to our selfishness?

Why does Satan promote false teaching and divisions?

How can you glorify God in your interactions with other Christians this next week?

**Day 56:** Review the passages and your answers from week 7

How will following the teachings in these passages demonstrate our love for others?

What rewards will we receive for following God?

What sins do you need to confess?

What new things have you learned about love as a result of this study that you will share with someone else?
